

## Community Summary

- **Warsaw** "Orthopedic Manufacturing Capital of the World,"
- Is the home to one of the **largest gravure printing presses** in the world.
- Home to the world's largest manufacturer of **projection screens**.
- Has over **100 natural lakes** (including the largest and deepest natural lakes in Indiana).
- The largest **biofuel plant** (Louis Dreyfus) in the United States is located in Claypool; 4<sup>th</sup> strongest **agricultural economies** in the state.
- Recreational areas abound in Warsaw and Kosciusko County.
- **Lake City Greenway**, a trail that traverses between Warsaw and Winona Lake with approximately 4.5 miles completed to date. The **CCAC (City-County Athletic Complex)** is located on the west side of Warsaw where over 3,000 softball and soccer games are played each year.
